Abstract. This chapter will describe the sensory innervation of the head and neck with special emphasis on anatomy relevant to regional anesthesia. The trigeminal (fifth cranial) nerve provides the majority of sensory innervation of the head, with exclusive coverage of the face. Fibers from the cervical plexus and the greater and lesser occipital nerves provide sensory innervation to the neck and back of the head.
