1. Hold the rods lightly in your hands, with elbows at your waist (90 degree angle) and forearms parallel to the ground. The rods should be held straight out, also parallel to the ground and parallel with each other. Do not place your thumbs over the bend of the handle, this will restrict movement.

Dowsing is an age-old art that has been used for centuries to locate water, graves, and buried items etc. I first learned about grave dowsing while working on "Cemetery Project's" in Iowa and Arizona. Since that time, I have conducted

Identifying Unmarked Graves Many times when visiting older cemeteries there will be indications of unmarked graves. These can be indicated by among other things, rectangular indentations in the

ground. There are a number of methods of determining the exact locations of these graves, including the following:

Saving Graves - Identifying Unmarked Graves

Examine the area where you suspect an unmarked grave is located. Note whether there is an abundance of rocks in the area that you are searching.

If the soil is full of rocks, you will most likely have to use another method since the rocks will give you false positives when the rod hits them during probing.

To probe for unmarked graves, you will need a metal probe measuring 3 to 3 1/2 feet in length and 1/8 inch in

diameter. It is best to use a probe fitted for replaceable steel tips since the tips wear out quickly.
