Generally, and with a few exceptions, leadership behaviour was found to be significantly related to organizational commitment, and organizational culture played an important role in moderating this relationship. Organizational commitment was found to be significantly associated with job satisfaction, but not with employee performance.

Teachers' level of adaptation of organizational commitment is moderate and is found to be at a high level in the sub-dimension of identification and internalization. Findings also indicate that the highest frequency of leadership behavior which is change-centered and the highest level of agreement on organizational commitment is affective commitment. Although there are not enough studies which examine such mechanisms between servant leadership and organizational commitment, the current investigation believes that there are other possible individual and organizational-level factors (e.g., self-efficacy, optimism, hope, trust, psychological capital, organizational culture, climate, policies, etc.) which are likely to mediate this expected association between servant leadership and organizational commitment.

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
