Public management entails dealing with and/ or controlling the needs and interests of 'the whole', which is in many cases the nation. Private management involves managing the narrower needs of an individual or group.

The Difference Between Public And Private Sector Management

The public management represents the set of processes and management relations, well defined, which exist between the components of the administrative system, which, in a public power, the laws are put into force and/or the activities in delivery of services satisfying the public interest are planned, organized, coordinated, managed and supervised.

CHARACTERISTICS OF PUBLIC SECTOR MANAGEMENT

Conflicts between private interests and public duties of public officials must therefore be correctly identified, appropriately managed, and effectively resolved. Left unresolved, a conflict of interest can result in corrupt conduct, abuse of public office, misconduct, breach of trust, or unlawful action.
