Physical Examination: Purpose, Preparation, and Procedure

The extent of the exam should correspond to the nature of the presenting problem, the standard of care, and the physicians' clinical judgment. Remember, medical necessity issues can arise if the physician performs and submits a claim for a comprehensive service involving a self-limiting problem.

E/M Coding Guidelines - AAPC

The 1995 E/M guidelines allow the physician to complete the physical exam by documenting organ systems or body areas. This approach is quite subjective and gives physicians a lot of leeway and "wiggle room." On the other hand, the 1997 E/M guidelines are quite rigid and force physicians to document the exam using specific bullets.

The school physical examination must be provided by the district medical director who is a physician or nurse practitioner duly licensed in New York State. The student must be separately and carefully examined. (Education Law Article 19 §904.)

Physician Practice E/M Guidelines

Spine: Neck and back are without deformity, external skin changes, or signs of trauma. Curvature of the cervical, thoracic, and lumbar spine are within normal limits. Bony features of the shoulders and hips are of equal height bilaterally. Posture is upright, gait is smooth, steady, and within normal limits.
