Based on the Standards, textbook evaluation has become expanded to include the 5 C's as well as the seven curricular elements. 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and curricular elements to assist in the selection process.

## **TEXTBOOK EVALUATION: A FRAMEWORK FOR EVALUATING THE ...**

Based on the review of the literature on the textbook evaluation checklists, the researchers created a tentative classification of textbook evaluation criteria (Figure 1). As the figure shows, we divided the list of criteria into the two general categories including „general attributes“ and „learning-teaching content“.
