Wastewater treatment system personnel can use COD as an almost real-time operational adjustment parameter. COD can test wastewater that is too toxic for the BOD test. The COD test should be considered an independent measure of the organic matter in a wastewater sample rather than a substitute for the BOD test.

**Wastewater Sample Problems**

Treated effluent from Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) flows through a cylindrical pipe of diameter (d)=0.6m. This pipe is slanted at an angle 30° towards the end to allow it to connect to a 2m x 6m closed top rectangular channel. After some distance, the rectangular channel is open to the atmosphere (A2).

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
